Hunting

Our 540 acres of woodlands are stocked annually with hundreds of Pheasant for your hunting pleasure. Our land abuts a 4,000 acre State Forest which is also open for hunting.



Archery Course

The Club has an excellent Archery facility consisting of a roofed over shooting line at the practice area with targets from 15 to 80 yards. A new Bow Hunter tower with 3D targets is also available. We also have an eighteen target walk-around course. The Archery area is open every day from sun-up to sun-down. The practice butts are available to non members for a fee, from 5 to 8 PM daily. Indoor Archery, 7:00 – 10:00am during the winter months. Fee \$20 for the season. Instructions available.



Primitive Arms Area

This is a Special area of about ten acres set aside for Black Powder shooting, knife and hawk throwing, and traditional Bow and Arrow shooting. This is an active area with a permanent lean-to type building. We hold two sanctioned competitive events a year. One in the Spring and one in the Fall. Cook your own Sunday morning breakfast on an open fire, then knife and hawk throwing and Black Powder shooting take place. 8:00am-12:00pm.



Rifle Range

Our 100 yard Rifle Range has 18 shooting positions under a roof, with 6 of them enclosed for year round shooting. We run indoor/outdoor Rifle matches on Sunday mornings in the winter, and a few other competition events thru the year, but our range is mostly used by members at random times. The Range is gated, but keys are available to all members for a nominal fee. An adjacent open area is being developed for additional shooting positions. Our newly paved parking area allows easy year round access.



ATV Activities

Our ATV group conducts monthly group rides thru many varied forest trails and cart roads.

Fishing Pond

Our Twenty-Two acre private pond is undergoing a three year weed control effort, but is still regularly stocked with Brook Trout. We also have plenty of native Bass, Pickerel, etc. We usually hold a couple of Fishing Derbies each year. The pond is open to members for fishing, row boating or canoeing.
